35 years since the accident, there has been a \$1billion cleanup at the plant and one of the two reactors at TMI still operates.

So it was the year of two spring breaks for F&M students. Fortunately, the College was able to adhere to its original academic calendar inspite of the unexpected second break. And students were able to catch a rescheduled on campus concert by the Charlie Daniels' Band. On campus students even received a rebate from the Saga dining room food service program - Hooray!

Interestingly, no more than two weeks before the TMI accident occurred a movie, The China Syndrome was released starring Jane Fonda and Jack Lemmon. It concerned a minor accident at a California nuclear power plant. Then editor of the College Reporter "We recommend The China Syndrome very highly. It's an excellent movie, even aside from its sudden and unwelcome relevance. If you haven't seen it, by all means do - it's certainly worth your \$3.50."
